This project will include new customer amenities such as weather-protected waiting areas, separate ADA-compliant boarding areas for each bus route and additional safety improvements. A dedicated bus turn lane will help to improve traffic flow and a new crosswalk across Ridge Avenue will allow pedestrians to access the Wissahickon Transportation Center more safely.
