In recognition of his tireless efforts to improve the working conditions of his fellow brothers and sisters Teamsters Local 623 established the William J. Cooke Memorial Scholarship. Bill "Cooke" was a Teamster member for 32 years. For more than half of his career, Cooke served as an elected Union officer.

Scholarships will be awarded on the basis of scholastic achievement and personal qualifications as determined by the Selection Committee. All applicants will be considered without regard to race, religion, gender, disability, or any other legally protected status. All awards will be delivered directly to the applicant.

- The child or grandchild of a member in good standing during the 12 months preceding the application deadline or, if retired or deceased, the member must have been in good standing for the 12 months preceding his/her retirement or death. The parent/grandparent cannot be a current officer/employee of the Local Union.
- Currently in their last year of high school and planning to attend an accredited college, university or vocational school.
