




Christmas Book Orders - signed copies of books



Paddy Manning is an investigative journalist who has worked for *The Australian*, *The Australian Financial Review*, *The Sydney Morning Herald*, *The*

Age, Crikey, ABC and The Monthly. He is completing a PhD at Macquarie University on 'A Century of News Corporation".

Paddy Manning explores Lachlan Murdoch's upbringing, political beliefs and role as head of Fox Corporation – the man ultimately responsible for Fox News. As heir apparent to his father's global media empire, Lachlan Murdoch is one of the world's most powerful people.


This is a book about the global media in the age of Trump and Biden. It is a book about power, apprenticeship, politics and succession.



Listening to Mal Hewitt OAM on 'Why ABC Friends' Update Newsletter is the ABC's Best Friend, at our last meeting, 14.9.23









At our last meeting Mal talked about his over 20 years of work on the <u>Update Newsletter</u> and why it has been such a good friend to ABC.

Mal talked about Update's articles including ones about the tragedy of ABC cutting its shortwave radio broadcasts in early 2017. When it was cut vast areas of remote Australia lost their capacity to listen to ABC radio and became 'radio deserts'. The consequences for the Pacific and South east Asia region

were also devastating when the ABC cut its shortwave radio frequencies <u>once</u> used by the ABC in the Pacific region.

After the meeting a few asked the question: " . . . but what about people living in remote areas of Australia using their mobile phones to receive ABC radio broadcasts?"

Mal replied, "The answer on mobile phones is that the signal dies about 30k out of Alice Springs. Also, very few First Nations people have mobile phones. Again, it is a different world in remote Australia."
