





# Why doesn't the ABC broadcast the Schools Spectacular anymore?



Thank you to those ABC Friends who joined NSoS to see the Schools Spectacular and the immense talent of over 5000 student performers from public schools and their teachers across NSW. This year's 40<sup>th</sup> Anniversary concert was simply magnificent.

Prue Car, NSW Deputy Premier, Minister for Education and Early Learning and Minister for Western Sydney described the Schools Specular as "an investment in enriching the lives of our young people" and that it is "an annual reminder of why an arts-rich education is so such a valuable part of live in our public schools. It creates well-rounded and enthusiastic learners and leaders. The arts do that magical thing of connecting our students with their culture as well as with the wider world".

Similar sentiments to the responsibility of the ABC as outlined in its Charter "to encourage and promote the musical, dramatic and other performing arts in Australia" and that ABC shall take account of "the provision of broadcasting programs of an educational nature—the responsibilities of the States in relation to education".

Ironically the 40<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the Schools Spectacular followed the day after the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary of public broadcasting was celebrated at the State Library of NSW.

Once the Schools Spectacular was broadcast each year by the ABC since it was first held in 1984. However it was handed over to Nine Network from 2013 until 2015. The Seven Network have been broadcasting the Schools Spectacular since 2016.

One asks why the ABC stopped broadcasting the NSW Schools Spectacular when education and the arts is core to its Charter. Funding cuts?

The Northern Suburbs of Sydney has invited Luke Wallace the Relieving Arts Coordination Officer, The Arts Unit, NSW Department of Education to talk about the School Spectacular's connections to the ABC at its 11 July 2024 meeting. Perhaps by then the NSW Department of Education may have reinstated the ABC as the preferred broadcaster for its 2024 School Spectacular? Let's live in hope.
