Please accept this letter of interest and short bio toward standing for election to the Provincial Board of the Alberta Party at the upcoming Annual General Meeting.

A proud Canadian who has lived significant periods of my life in Alberta, Ontario, and Quebec, I bring a pan-Canadian vision toward moderate, pragmatic, and centrist political engagement. A long-time federal progressive conservative, I came to the Alberta Party in summer 2016, becoming engaged until my return to Montreal in January 2019. During that period, I contributed to election readiness as a regional and provincial trainer and supported both the Strathcona and Strathcona-Sherwood Park CA's toward the 2019 provincial general election. I held an organizational and advisory role with the Kara Levis leadership campaign in 2018.

My aim is to work collaboratively with the other Board members to provide direction, guidance, and support to all party members as we work to organize at the leadership, regional, and constituency levels.

I would be honoured to continue to serve in a Board capacity, bringing to bear my own experience, bilingual communications, and project management skills.
