Dear Friend,

Thank you for being a voice for the unborn in South Australia.

Encouraging fellow members of your church or group to take action will be crucial in stopping the extreme abortion legislation now before our State Parliament.

At this stage, taking action primarily involves organising members of your church or group to handwrite letters to our MLCs (upper house MPs), ideally a minimum of two MLCs per person, but as many as people are willing to write to.

To assist you and your letter-writers, we have prepared an information sheet containing facts about the bill and other relevant points that can be incorporated into letters (ideally in people's own words).

The names and contact details for MLCs are included on the information sheet. Again, please encourage people to write to at least two people on this list – but to as many as they're willing.

Remember, you and your group are part of a coordinated state-wide campaign to fight this extreme legislation. Thank you for your important contribution – and you are not alone!

Tips for you as a local coordinator:

- If possible, ask your priest/pastor/minister/leader to share some words of support for this campaign with your church or group. You could give them a copy of this letter and of the information sheet.
- Set up a letter-writing table in your hall or a suitably prominent place. Encourage as many people as possible to spend a few minutes writing to at least two MLCs.

- Encourage multiple people to write letters at the same time, avoiding queues. You may want to repeat the process over several weeks in order to gain as many participants as possible.
- The table needs to have copies of the information sheet, from which people can take a few points and write them in their own words. They will also copy their MLC's name and contact details from the sheet provided to you. It is important that the writer provides their own return address at the end of each letter (beneath their name) to prove their South Australian credentials to the MLC. This could also prompt a letter of reply.
- Letters should be folded, placed in an envelope, addressed and posted by the writer as soon as possible. Your church or group could also arrange delivery of all letters written using the Parliament House address provided on the contact details sheet.

If your priest/pastor/minister/leader would prefer this activity not be undertaken at the church premises, please pass the information and contact detail sheets directly to potential participants, explain the process and ask them to write letters as soon as they get home.

Once again, thank you for your support. By working together, we can be an effective voice for the voiceless, and stand together against this extreme legislation.
