1.) Proof of Identity	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Passport • Matricula Consular • Driver's License or State-issued ID Card • Birth certificate and a photo identification (such as school of military ID with photo) • Any U.S. government immigration or other document bearing your name and photo
2.) Proof you came to the United States before your 16 th birthday	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • School records from the schools you have attended in the U.S. (If available, please also include elementary school and middle school records) • Travel Records • Hospital or medical records (immunization records, Doctor notes, prescriptions) • Passport with Admission Stamp • Form I-94/I-95/I-94W
3.) Proof of Presence in the U.S. on June 15, 2012 <p style="text-align: center;"><u>AND</u></p> 4.) Proof you continuously resided in the U.S. since June 15, 2007 (recommended 1 document for every 3 months)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • School records (letters, report cards, etc) • Employment records (pay stubs, W-2 Forms, etc) • Rent/mortgage receipts or utility bills (cell phone, cable, electric, etc) • Military records (Form DD-214 or NGB Form 22) • Birth certificate of children born in the U.S. • Hospital or medical records for self or child(ren) (immunizations, prescriptions, etc) • Copies of money order receipts for money sent in or out of the country • Passport entries • Official records from a religious entity confirming participation in a religious ceremony (i.e., baptism or wedding) • Automobile license receipts or registration • Deeds, mortgages, rental agreement contracts • Dated bank transactions, bank account statements • Financial records (bank statements, receipts/invoices for purchases with your name on them, Federal income tax returns, tax receipts, insurance documents, etc.)

Proof that you meet the Education requirement	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • U.S. High school diploma or certificate of completion • U.S. G.E.D certificate <p><i>If you have not yet completed high school or received a G.E.D:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • School records (transcripts, report cards, etc) from the school that you are currently attending in the United States showing (a) the name of the school and (b) periods of school attendance and (c) your current educational or grade level.
6.) If applicable: Proof you are an honorably discharged veteran of the U.S. Armed Forces or the U.S. Coast Guard	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Form DD-214, Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Duty • NGB Form 22, National Guard Report of Separation and Record of Service • Military personnel records • Military health records
7.) If applicable: Proof of immigration status	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Form I-94/I-95/I-94W
8.) If applicable:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Previously granted Employment Authorization Card • Social Security Card issued to you by the U.S. Social Security Administration
