

Initiative 83 is at risk



We Won!

Last November, Initiative 83 won with a supermajority in every ward in DC. Now the DC Council might take part of this victory away.

What Now?

In order for Initiative 83 to take effect for the 2026 elections, the DC Council has to provide **implementation funding** to the Board of Elections. Council agreed on July 14 to fund ranked choice voting — but that's only half of the initiative. Council needs to finish the job and provide funding to allow independents to participate in taxpayer-funded primary elections.

How Much Does It Cost?

The cost is estimated at around \$1.5 million over four years, with most of the expense going to one-time voter education materials.

What's at Stake?

With the recent attempts to weaken Home Rule and reduce the limited autonomy DC currently enjoys, it is more important than ever to stand up to protect democracy and increase representation in our communities.

What Can I Do?

The budget is being finalized NOW, with final votes taking place on Monday, July 28! Email Council today to say that you expect them to respect the will of the people.
