ABS. Causes of Death 2023



Male suicides are more often linked to social issues than female suicides

6x more suicides linked to legal issues

6x more suicides linked to drug and alcohol abuse

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4.5x more suicides in people not in the labour force

4x more suicides linked to economic hardship

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4x more suicides linked to divorce and separation

Nearly 4x more suicides linked to relationship issues

Most men who die by suicide are in contact with services prior to taking their lives.

**90%** of people with a mental health diagnosis who die by suicide were in treatment (VIC).

**9 in 10** people who die by suicide were in contact with community services (TAS).
