Nominations, which must be in writing and comply with the registered rules of the Organisation, may be made at any time from 28/10/2025. Additional forms are available from the Returning Officer.

Prospective candidates and nominators should verify their financial status and any other qualifications required by the Organisation's rules prior to lodging nominations.

Nominations must reach the Returning Officer via the lodgement method(s) stipulated below **not later than 12:00 Noon Australian Eastern Daylight Time (AEDT) on 18/11/2025.**

How to lodge nominations, nominations must be lodged via the following method(s):

By Email: A properly completed nomination form including all necessary signatures and attachments may be scanned and submitted as a **PDF** file to IEBnominations@aec.gov.au

PLEASE NOTE:

1. Emails to the AEC inbox that appear to be spam may be blocked. It is the responsibility of senders to ensure that their email reaches the AEC before the deadline for nominations.
2. In order to be able to be received by the AEC, emails (including attachments) should be no greater than 6 MB in size.
3. Following the close of nominations, all nominations will undergo eligibility checks to determine if they are complete and all rule requirements are met. Where an issue has been identified the Returning Officer will advise the candidate and provide an opportunity to remedy the defect within a specified period.
4. The Returning Officer will notify all candidates of the outcome of the eligibility checks when the nominations accepted report is issued.
5. The subject line of your email should read **"ANDDP – E2025/133 – Nomination [insert name]"**

Withdrawing Nominations

Nominations cannot be withdrawn after 12:00 Noon Australian Eastern Daylight Time (AEDT) on 25/11/2025.

Voting Period

The ballot, if required, will open on 22/12/2025 and close at 10:00am Australian Eastern Daylight Time (AEDT) on 28/01/2026.

Scrutineers

The appointment of scrutineers closes 12:00 Noon Australian Eastern Daylight Time (AEDT) on 18/11/2025. A form is available from the Returning Officer for the purposes of appointing Scrutineers.
