In 2017, the Islamophobic anti-M103 movement had 10,000 to 20,000 supporters.

In 2019, the Yellow Vests had 250,000 supporters, and launched the first convoy.

In 2022, we estimate there are over a million supporters of the COVID conspiracy movement, and some of them occupied Ottawa.
