

Why do we need to Solar Our Learning?

- Energy costs are an increasing burden and too many schools and early childhood centres are missing out on the benefits of bill-busting clean energy installations.
- Solar and batteries for all schools and childcare centres can save schools money, reduce childcare costs, and employ thousands of people - it's a win-win-win.
- This is Australia's largest clean energy proposal that will benefit every community in the country.

Solar Our Learning will:

- Slash school and childcare energy bills, freeing up funds for learning resources and childcare places
- Save large schools \$114,000 in energy bills per year, and small schools or childcares \$12,400 - \$14,600 a year
- Create at least 6,870 renewable energy jobs in all regions of Australia.
- Save millions of tonnes of carbon emissions per year

What's this campaign about?

Problem:

All children deserve high-quality early education and care. But rising energy costs are cutting into early childhood centre budgets that could otherwise pay staff, and reduce costs to families.

Early education and care centres have better things to spend money on than power bills. While bigger chains like Goodstart and G8 are already installing solar and saving money

Barriers like insufficient staff time, unwilling property owners, lack of access to reliable information, and upfront costs mean most centres don't have the capacity to organise clean energy upgrades, even though it would save them money.

So they're paying more for energy than centres with more capacity - that's unfair

Solution:

More clean energy keeps our kids safer, now and into the future. And the benefits of high-quality early education are huge, both for kids and parents.

Rooftop solar saves money for everyone, paying for itself in under three years, but too many providers are not in a position to install it.

At a time when energy bills are putting pressure on early education centres everywhere, we would encourage all state and federal governments to invest in rooftop solar for all schools and early learning centres.

Benefit:

Australia's 9,000 school rooftops alone have the potential for 950MW of solar - that's the capacity of a Snowy Hydro generator. But we can start building it right now, without the long approvals required for large projects.

And adding solar to the 16,000 early learning services will not only add even more grid capacity, but save them money they'd rather spend on staffing additional places for kids.
