

RIGHTS CARD

I am exercising my constitutional right to remain silent and not answer any questions. I am giving you this card because I have the right to remain silent and choose not to speak to you. If you arrest me, I will continue exercising that constitutional right. I request to speak with a lawyer of my choosing before answering any questions.

MY RIGHTS

I HAVE THE RIGHT TO NOT OPEN THE DOOR. If you open the door, you give “permission” to the immigration agent to enter.

I HAVE THE RIGHT TO REMAIN SILENT. Remember that you can remain silent and not answer any questions.

I HAVE THE RIGHT NOT TO SIGN ANYTHING. Legal documents are complicated to understand. Do not sign anything until it is reviewed by an attorney you trust.

If you are stopped on the street, ask if you are “detained.” If you are told no, you can walk away right away.

If you are detained, give this card to the officer and say, “I will not answer any questions. I want to speak to my lawyer.”
