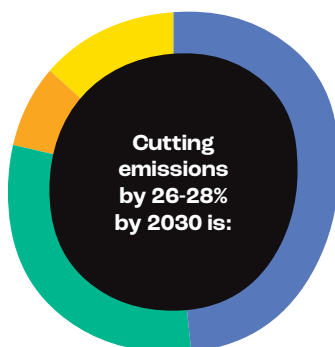

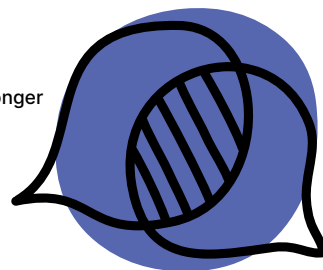

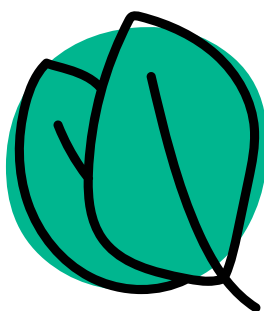

### These are the top **local solutions:**



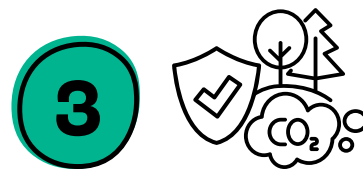
Replace gas and coal-fired power stations with renewable energy and battery storage

**25%**



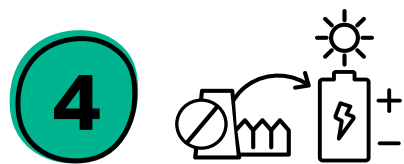
Invest in clean transport - more electric buses and trains, and a national network of electric vehicle charging stations

**16%**



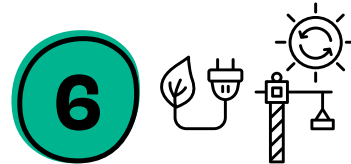
Only allocate public money to support renewable energy and battery storage projects, and not coal and gas projects
