Subject: Continuation of Judicial Opinion 14.002

Pursuant to Judicial Opinion 14.002 Adams v. Gladden requiring Comptroller Gisselle Gladden to comply with the terms of her probation period following the term of her suspension, and

Pursuant to Judicial Opinion 14.002 Adams v. Gladden requiring the Judicial Board to convene to discuss further sanctions in the event of a violation of the terms of the probation, and

Whereas one of the conditions of the probation was the submission to the Chair of the Judicial Board, as well as the publication of, a fiscal-activities report for the month of February, and

Whereas the submission deadline for this report was before March 1st, and

Whereas Comptroller Gladden failed to submit such a report to the Chair, and

Whereas the Judicial Board convened electronically to discuss and agree on further sanctions, compliant with Judicial Opinion 14.002 Adams v. Gladden, therefore be it

Held that Comptroller Gladden, having been found in violation of the terms of her probation, is hereby resuspended for a period of an addition two weeks beginning at 12pm on March 3rd, 2019, and lasting until 12pm on March 17th, 2019, and therefore be it also

Held that Comptroller Gladden’s period of probation, shall resume at 12pm on March 17th, 2019, and last until 12pm on April 7th, 2019, and therefore be it also

Held that Comptroller Gladden shall be expected to meet the same probation requirements as laid out in Judicial Opinion 14.002, with the new deadline of a fiscal activities report being April 1st, and the deadline for the other expectations being April 7th, and therefore be it also

Held that the Board believes Comptroller Gladden has met the requirement set out in the Bylaws of what constitutes one of the “causes of impeachment”, as described in the Bylaws Article XIV.1.iv., the cause being “failing to meet the requirements of [her] position as stated in Student Government Constitution and Student Government Bylaws”, and therefore be it also

Held that the Judicial Board, in accordance with the Judicial Register, formally requests from the Undergraduate Senate the impeachment and subsequent removal of Comptroller Gladden from her position as Comptroller of the Student Government.
