Re: EAW Classification Appeal Update

We want to provide an update as to the Classification Referee's anticipated decision on the EAW appeal. We do not know when to expect a decision, but the Referee has advised that her work is taking more time than originally anticipated due to the extensive evidence relating to such a large number of factors in dispute. This is not unexpected in hearings of this nature, particularly as there was such a large volume of documentary evidence. We know EAWs are concerned to know the outcome, but from the Union's perspective we would rather she take the time to consider all of the evidence and our arguments.

We will provide further updates as we receive more information.
