***Correction to Feb 25, 2019 FYI Notice***

Did you know that as a casual you may be eligible for benefits? According to Article 29.9:

*"Upon completion of 180 hours of work, casual employees shall be given the option to enrol in the following plans:*

*Article 25.1 - BC Medical Plan*

*Article 25.2 - Dental Plan*

*Article 25.3 - Extended Health Plan*

*An employee who makes an election under this provision must enrol in each and every of the benefit plans and shall not be entitled to except any of them"*

**CORRECTION:** To enroll, you must pre-pay the costs of benefits.

If you post into a position that is 6 months or longer, the benefits are then paid by the employer.
