All EV Types Can Use Public Chargers

Please share resources. PHEVs, small and large BEVs all have equal rights to charging.

When to Unplug Another Vehicle

Only when it has finished charging or when you have permission.

Observe Parking Limits

And do not park illegally to reach a charger.

Don't Set and Forget

Be back at your vehicle before charging stops. Don't expect others to unplug you.

Charging Not Parking

Only use parks with this sign if you are actively charging.

Monitor With Your Phone

Use apps and text alerts. Plugshare is a safer way to communicate with users.

Be Nice to ICE

Be a good EV Ambassador. Only leave polite notes if charger is blocked.

E-Stop is Only for Emergencies

If instructed to push e-stop, reset it before you leave by twisting to the right.

Okay to Check Progress

To determine wait time, check the on-screen status and icons.

These are Your Stations

Report any issues to service provider, not land owner. Stow cables neatly.
