A critical aspect of Vision Zero is focusing on safety for vulnerable road users, as <u>cyclists and pedestrians are 21 times more likely to be killed in a traffic crash compared to a motorist according to the Knoxville Regional TPO. The City of Knoxville has a <u>Vision Zero Action Plan</u> to highlight the strategies and actions our community can take to make our streets safe for all users.</u>
