At just 24 years old, Belgarde brings nearly a decade of experience in right-wing politics. He began as a volunteer for Donald Trump's 2016 presidential campaign during the Republican primary in 2015 and has since worked across a range of political campaigns and nonprofit organizations. His background spans grassroots organizing, political communications, and election-focused advocacy, with a particular emphasis on California.

Belgarde is the founder of Stamp the Vote Action and Stamp the Vote PAC, two organizations dedicated to influencing elections in the San Francisco Bay Area through volunteer mobilization and targeted voter outreach.

He is also the author of the forthcoming book "The Patriots Playbook: Why Young Americans Need to Get Involved and Be the Change", which argues for greater civic participation among younger Americans and outlines a vision for political renewal driven by grassroots energy rather than entrenched institutions.

Belgarde's core mission is to shape the next generation of the American right—steering young conservatives toward a populist, America First, nationalist movement and away from what he views as a failed establishment of Republican policies and leadership of the past.
