

The Armor of God

God's armor is given to Christians by faith in order to help us win over our temptations.

Part 1 - Put on the Armor

We must remember that our real enemy is the devil, not other people. The only way we can win over Satan's power is by using God's power. Our own strength is not enough.

Part 2 - God's Power is Found in the Armor

Because God's power is found in the armor, we must understand what each part of the armor is, and then prepare ourselves to use it. Below on the left is a list of the parts of the armor. On the right is a list of their meanings or uses. Using **Ephesians 6:14-18** and careful thought, place the letter before each meaning or use in the blank in front of the correct part. (Ask for help if needed)

Part of the Armor	Its Meaning or Use
1. ____ Belt of truth	a. "Jesus is my Savior and Lord."
2. ____ Breastplate of righteousness	b. Extinguishes (puts out) the enemy's flaming arrows.
3. ____ Feet fitted with readiness	c. God's Word will strike down the enemy.
4. ____ Shield of faith	d. Character quality of truthfulness.
5. ____ Helmet of salvation	e. Prayer that depends on God's Spirit to help.
6. ____ Sword of the Spirit	f. Speed the gospel to others.
7. ____ Pray in the Spirit	g. The character quality of a holy (righteous) life.

To get a better picture of how God's armor protects us, **take a look at the image on the next page** and follow the instructions given.

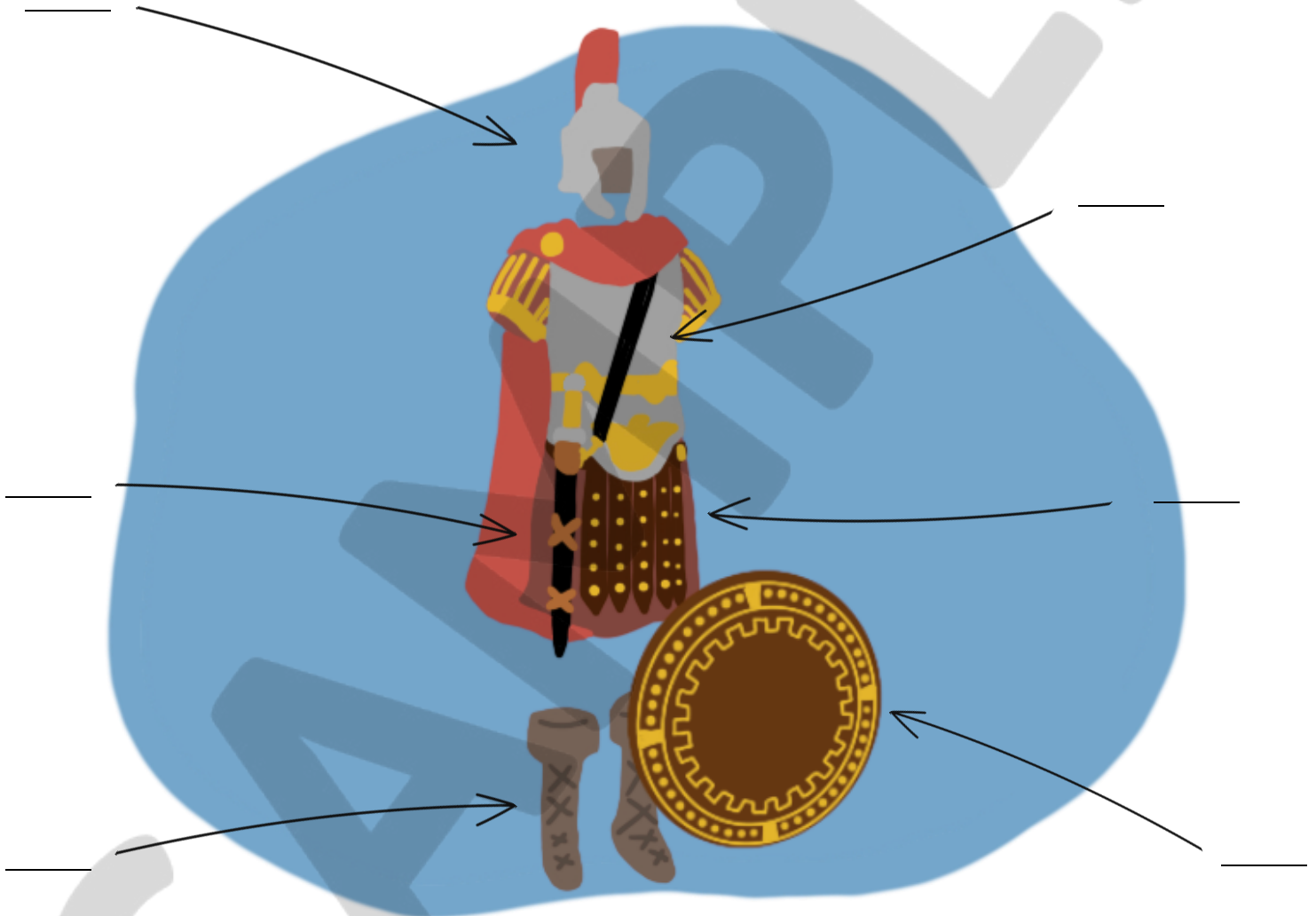
Note that there is no armor part for prayer, because it is the **invisible part** of the armor. **Prayer is important!** (See **Ephesians 6:18**)
