2019 was a year for the record books for Bradbury-Sullivan LGBT Community Center. Thanks to tremendous community support, we eliminated our mortgage after only four years. We produced 53 free arts and culture programs, offered 13 monthly supportive services, and served more than 500 LGBT youth in our after school drop-in program. What's more, we sued the Trump Administration to block the denialof-care rule, we produced a pride festival with a special focus on accessibility and inclusion for people with disabilities, and we continued to lead the way toward LGBT health equity. The work of this organization is making a profound difference in the Lehigh Valley, in Pennsylvania, and beyond. The COVID-19 pandemic means that our work is needed even more than ever.

Youth Programs

Bradbury-Sullivan LGBT Community Center's youth programs offered in collaboration with Valley Youth House, provide youth (age 14-21) with leadership opportunities through a safe, youth-led drop-in space.

Lehigh Valley Pride

Lehigh Valley Pride is a celebration of LGBT art, culture, community, and visibility. The festival, attended by more than **5,000** people, features drag, music, visual art, youth and teen programs, drag bingo, faith programs, and more than 150 vendors including nonprofits, retailers, and artists.



In addition to the pride festival itself, Bradbury-Sullivan LGBT Community Center also produces **Pride Nights** at the **Lehigh Valley IronPigs** and the **Lehigh Valley Phantoms**.

The Training Institute

The Training Institute at Bradbury-Sullivan LGBT Community Center provides specialized training for educators, health professionals, older adult care providers, and social service agencies to help them improve their outreach and services to the LGBT community.
