Numbers to Be Proud Of: Using Data to Fuel Your Pride Programming In this presentation, attendees will 1) identify the different types of stakeholders that may want specific information about their Pride programming,

- 3) discuss what publicly available information may be useful in establishing new partnerships and programs for their Pride events.

This session will share information from Lehigh Valley Pride about how disability justice is incorporated, with tangible ideas all Pride celebrations can consider to ensure that Pride is truly for everyone!
