Commonwealth Electoral Amendment (Stop the Lies) Bill 2022

The issue:

- Referenda are particularly vulnerable to misinformation and disinformation
- Almost 75% of Australian came across false political advertising during the last election
- Without truth in political advertising laws, disinformation may pollute the Voice referendum—as it did the Marriage Equality plebiscite.

The opportunity:

- 86% of Australians want truth in political advertising laws
- There is overwhelming support across the political spectrums
- The 'Stop the Lies' Bill is based on SA legislation proven to be effective, timely, and constitutionally sound.

Why is the Bill necessary?

- This Bill fills a vulnerability in Australia's electoral law.
- Existing protections against false political advertising are insufficient.
- Extensive research shows that false political advertising is corrosive to our democracy, elections, and referenda.

Does this infringe the implied freedom of political communication?

 This Bill approaches the regulation of political advertising with caution and respect for our constitutional freedom of political communication.
