

### **METHODOLOGY**

The survey was conducted with 1,500 Canadian adults from July 13<sup>th</sup> to 19<sup>th</sup>,2021. A random sample of panelists were invited to complete the survey from a set of partner panels based on the Lucid exchange platform. These partners are typically double opt-in survey panels, blended to manage out potential skews in the data from a single source.


The margin of error for a comparable probability-based random sample of the same size is +/- 2.5%, 19 times out of 20.

The data were weighted according to census data to ensure that the sample matched Canada's population according to age, gender, educational attainment, official language, and region. Totals may not add up to 100 due to rounding.













THE INCOME DIFFERENCES BETWEEN THE RICHEST 1% AND YOUR PERSONAL SALARY










FEELINGS OF STRESS/MENTAL WORRY ABOUT MONEY








How worried, if at all, are you personally about your cost of living and having enough income to pay for the things you need and want in your life?
