SUBJECT: The 2022 Left Unity Slate campaign, and beyond

BACKGROUND and PURPOSE: For the first time in California history, two ballot-qualified political parties mutually-endorsed a slate of statewide candidates and had those endorsements printed in official voter information guides across the state. How did the "Left Unity Slate" campaign of Green Party and Peace and Freedom Party candidates fare, what lessons were learned, and how might we build for the future? Not only in terms of votes, but also regarding publicity, connections, volunteers, endorsements, and more.

PROPOSAL: We would like to invite each Left Unity Slate candidate to present the highlights of their campaign for about 3 to 4 minutes (focusing on the above questions), and then take questions and comments from the GA attendees. The SCSC will make a brief introduction, summarizing the election results, endorsements received, and perhaps a few other aspects of the overall campaign.

COMMITTEE DECISION: The SCSC consensed for this proposal to be submitted.
