The aircraft of course is a DeHavilland Dash-8 and was being ferried from Canada to New Zealand in 2005. Mike had wondered about the registration letters, which are still Canadian ones, C-FCPO. With the "CP" in there he suspected the mark had originally belonged to a CP Air aircraft. Sure enough, it had belonged to a Douglas DC-8-63 until December 1990.

It was later assigned to this Dash-8 in January 2005 during its manufacture in Downsview ON, and carried the registration through to its ferry flight to New Zealand that July. The mark is now on a Piper PA-28-236 in Brantford ON.




