### **Hope Air – Steve Drinkwater**

Editor's Note: Steve is a CAP member and was part of our fly-in last year to Qualicum, and also attended our Vancouver year-end party in 2022. We are pleased to feature and support this fund-raising effort for Hope Air, a charity which provides travel arrangements for those from remote areas who are in need of health care.





Now in our 6<sup>th</sup> year, I will be embarking on an 8-day expedition departing Pitt Meadows airport on the morning of June 10, leading a group of pilots to Northern British Columbia, plus Watson Lake, Yukon and Grande Prairie, Alberta before returning through Central and Southern B.C.

This is to raise funds for, and awareness of, Hope Air, the national charity that raises funds to

provide travel arrangements for those in need of health care in distant locations but face financial challenges.

So far, "Give Hope Wings" has raised over \$1.8 million for Hope Air. Please have a look at Hope Air's 2022 Impact Report to learn more about the impact you can make through your donation. There, you can view a short, 2-minute video about how you can help change the lives of people like Atticus and his family.


