Hi everyone! My name is Chelsea Bryson. I am here to try and take on the impossible and represent my brother Tyler Bryson in this honor given to him by the first CAP award.


My brother Tyler was set in what he wanted to do at a young age - starting ground school at the age of 14, and began a love of aviation which lasted 20 years. He was named as the top all around student at his BCIT Aviation program, then early in his career went on to instruct other students & work for a few smaller regional or charter airlines. Eventually he made his way to captain at Westjet Encore, and then became an FO at Westjet with 5000 flight hours.

One thing that felt as strong as Tyler's love of flying was his dedication to helping other people. He was kind to everyone around him, and he had a way of making everyone in his life feel like a priority. Anytime Tyler had the opportunity to help, you best believe he'd be going out of his way to do so. His ability to be empathetic and understanding to all those around him in every circumstance was unsurpassed.

The thing is, there were definitely moments where Tyler's amazing character was not the focus. At times it seemed like who someone loves was a bigger deal than who they are as a person, which is such a frustrating concept. Tyler only wanted to focus on his career and doing what he loved, but instead he had to spend time worrying about how he may be perceived. Despite this, he continued to think only of others, and instead of being bitter, focused on making positive change for as many people as he possibly could.

The idea that this award can be given out to help a community of people which gave him such amazing friends and colleagues within Aviation is such a perfect way to honor him. This truly encapsulates who he was and what was important to him. I just hope that with this, and other continued support for the LGBTQ+ community, that eventually no one in this world has to be patient or brave in order to be themselves.

We want to thank the CAP organization for their honor in giving this award in Tyler's name, and their work in creating a place of friendship and safety. Know that myself and my family are cheering you on as you all continue into your careers and become the amazing people you are.

February 1st 2024

Three of the five Directors were present, and after approval of the minutes of the Annual General Meeting, a review of the applications for the new CAP Award was held. Directors unanimously agreed to make awards to four candidates pending reference checks. The award will honour the late Tyler Bryson who was instrumental in setting up the awards, and his family has been contacted to provide input.

Applications for the position of Executive Director have been received, and Rene will take the lead for interviews of those applicants who meet the qualifications.

Peter advised that he has ordered merchandise to boost the inventory and will begin coordinating June Pride events with the NGPA. Other summer events will be added to the calendar as dates become known.

Work will begin this spring on the new Strategic Plan, which will include the assessment of statistics especially to use for grant applications, this being one of the duties of the new Executive Director position. The meeting was adjourned after 40 minutes.


