In an ongoing effort to provide safety to tenants, employees, and all law abiding members of the public, the applicant requests that this portion of the skyway be open from 6:00 A.M. – 7:00 P.M. This is an emergency request in light of the increased crime, violence, loitering, assaults, drug violations, weapons violations and other criminal offenses in this skyway that are never prosecuted by the City of St. Paul (unfortunately).

There are too many known criminal violations that have occurred in this portion of the skyway to list on paper. The City of Saint Paul is aware of the constant violations but nonetheless does not routinely patrol the skyways or bring charges against the violators. The criminals know this as well. Together, this creates a haven for criminals to congregate freely to use drugs, consume alcohol, urinate, defecate, fight, use weapons, harass citizens and tenants, and do other illegal acts which are never prosecuted by the City of St. Paul.

By way of one example, on February 28, 2023, in this portion of the skyway, there were approximately 30-50 people engaged in fighting, hitting, battery using fists and even 2x4 boards, among other things. Although the police eventually came to help break up the fighting and disperse the people involved, it is always too late as the skyways during the time were obviously not safe at all for any law abiding citizen who happened to be in the skyway at this time.

Moreover, the security personnel for US Bank Center, Alliance Bank Center, and other properties are threatened, assaulted, and/or battered on a daily basis. Additionally, as everyone knows, two men were recently shot and killed inside the building connecting the light rail Green Line Central Station to this portion of the skyway system. They were shooting guns in the skyway at one another. Fortunately no bystanders were killed (this time). Following these killings, the City of St. Paul closed the building at Cedar and 5th at the train station. This was done for safety reasons per all of the articles and public information that the applicant has reviewed.
