## STUDENT DEBT

THE WEEKLY LOAN LIMIT OF THE CANADA STUDENT LOANS PROGRAM HAS NOT INCREASED SINCE THE 2004 FEDERAL BUDGET

RIGHT NOW, 67,000 STUDENTS BENEFITING FROM A CANADA STUDENT LOAN ALSO HAVE TO TAKE OUT PRIVATE LOANS TO COVER THE COST OF THEIR EDUCATION


