



2018 Statistics

Children

- 1,811 children served by CASA volunteers and staff members
 - 71% of the total number of children in Child Protective Services' care in Travis County
- 807 new children assigned to CASA
- 763 children's cases closed with the help of CASA
 - 63% (477) of children were reunified with their parent(s)
 - 16% (120) of children were adopted by or now live permanently with relatives
 - 5% (38) of children were adopted by or now live permanently with non-relatives
 - 5% (38) of children became adults (turned 18) while in care of the state
 - 11% (90) - the remaining children's cases were served by another county court system, had their case dismissed or had other outcomes
- 900 children still needed a CASA volunteer

Volunteers

- 736 active volunteers assigned to children
- 232 new volunteers took a case in 2018

Demographics

- Race and ethnicity of children served:
 - Hispanic/Latino = 50%
 - Black/African-American = 26%
 - White = 17%
 - Bi-Racial/Multi-Racial = 5%
 - Asian/Asian-American = 1%
 - Other/Not Specified = 1%
- Ages and gender of children served:
 - 0-4 = 30%
 - 5-13 = 50%
 - 14-17 = 17%
 - 18 and over = 3%
 - 50% male; 50% female
- Race and ethnicity of active volunteers:
 - Hispanic/Latino = 12%
 - Black/African-American = 4%
 - White = 78%
 - Bi-Racial/Multi-Racial = 2%
 - Asian/Asian-American = 3%
 - Other/Not Specified = 1%
- Ages and gender of active volunteers:
 - 21-29 = 18%
 - 30-39 = 27%
 - 40-49 = 17%
 - 50-59 = 20%
 - 60+ = 18%
 - 15% male; 85% female
