IF YOU'RE A HOMEOWNER...

and you want to make your home more weather-resistant?

Miami-Dade County Weatherization Assistance

Income Limit at or Below:

- 1 member in household: \$30,120
- 2 members in household: \$40,880
- 3 members in household: \$51,640
- 4 members in household: \$62,400
- 5 members in household: \$73,160
- 6 members in household: \$83,920
- 7 members in household: \$94,680
- 8 members in household: \$105,440
- + \$10,760 each additional person

Additional Requirements:

- Valid Social Security Card for all household members
- Proof of income for the past 12 months
- Valid FL driver's license or State ID for all household residents 18 years and older
- Proof of homeownership
- Most recent FPL bill

Eligible for:

- Attic insulation
- Low-flow showerheads
- Water heater jackets
- Energy-efficient light bulbs
- Weather-stripping
- Energy Recovery Ventilation (ERV), including bathroom and kitchen exhaust fans
- Repair or replacement of exterior doors, windows, refrigerators, water heaters and cooling and heating systems

My Safe Florida Home

Income Limit at or Below:

- 1 member in household: \$104,160
- 2 members in household: \$118,920
- 3 members in household: \$133,800
- 4 members in household: \$146,680
- 5 members in household: \$160,680
- 6 members in household: \$172,560
- 7 members in household: \$184,440
- 8 members in household: \$196,320

ALL of these statements must be true to qualify for the state-funded My Safe Florida Home program.

- Your home must be a single-family, detached residential property or townhouse.
- Your home must be site-built and owner-occupied.
- You must have been granted a homestead exemption on the home.
- The home must be a dwelling with an insured value of \$700,000 or less.
- The building permit application for initial construction of the home must have been made before January 1, 2008.

You qualify for a free inspection through the My Safe Florida Home program! After inspection, homeowners may apply for a grant covering two-thirds of approved mitigation projects, up to \$10,000.

Potential home improvements include:

- Strengthen Roof to Deck Attachments
- Reinforce Roof-to-Wall Connections
- Install Secondary Water Resistance for Roof
- Window Upgrades
- Exterior Door Upgrades

IF YOU'RE A RENTER OR A HOMEOWNER...

Need help paying your power bill?

Are you a Florida Power & Light (FPL) customer in danger of being disconnected/are already disconnected?

Is your household income at or below the ALICE threshold for your county? (Use the [United Way ALICE Household Calculator](#) to check.)

You are likely eligible for FPL's Care to Share program!

The program offers up to \$750 in emergency assistance to low-income Miami-Dade households at risk of utility disconnection. Eligible residents can apply once every 12 months.

Eligible for County water rebate program!

Purchase EPA WaterSense certified toilet/faucet/showerhead (proof of purchase required):

- \$50 rebate per toilet
- \$25 rebate per faucet
- \$25 rebate per showerhead (max 2 per household)
