CEIU is hereby calling for nominations for the position of Alternate National Vice-President for Women's Priorities, Western Region.

### ELIGIBILITIES of a **NOMINEE**, a **NOMINATOR**, and a **SECONDER**

In accordance with CEIU By-Law 12, sub-section 12.3.3, any member in good standing who identify as a woman in each of the areas defined in By-Law 13, sub-section 13.1 (e), and, which are listed below for ease of reference, may nominate or second another member in good standing who identify as a woman in each of the areas defined below for the position of Alternate National Vice-President for Women's Priorities, Western Canada.

Western Canada is comprised of the regions of British Columbia/Yukon Territory, Alberta/Northwest Territories/Nunavut, Saskatchewan-Manitoba, and Ontario.

**IMPORTANT:** *Please ensure that, as the nominee, nominator and/or seconder, you are eligible to sign the nomination form as per the eligibilities listed above.*

### DEADLINE DATE to receive **NOMINATIONS**

Completed nomination forms for the Alternate NVP for Women's Priorities, Western Canada position must be received at the CEIU National Office in Ottawa by **no later than 4:30 p.m. (EST) on Thursday, May 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2024**, to be considered valid.

## ELECTRONIC VOTING

If CEIU receives more than one nomination for the position of A/NVP for Women's Priorities, Western Canada, elections will be done by electronic vote. The election period will be for a period of eight (8) consecutive days, **starting at 9 a.m. (EST) on May 21<sup>st</sup>, 2024, and ending at 4:30 p.m. (EST) on May 28<sup>th</sup>, 2024.**

Any member in good standing from Western Canada, and who identify as a women, and for which CEIU has a personal email address in its database will be eligible to vote for the Alternate NVP for Women's Priorities, Western Canada – *as per the section Eligibilities above.*

Employer email addresses cannot be used for electronic voting.
