RE: **2<sup>nd</sup> Callout for the 2025 CEIU National Scholarships**

As a member in good standing of the Canada Employment and Immigration Union (CEIU), a component of the Public Service Alliance of Canada (PSAC), I am pleased to be sending you the **2<sup>nd</sup> Callout for the 2025 CEIU National Scholarships**.

For the 2<sup>nd</sup> callout of 2025, the scholarships will be offered and prioritized in the following order:

**1) Five equity scholarships**

- At least 1 scholarship offered to a person that identifies as Indigenous Peoples
- At least 1 scholarship is offered to a person that identifies as a Member with Disabilities.
- At least 1 scholarship offered to a person that identifies as LGBTQ2+
- At least 1 scholarship offered to a person that identifies as Racialized Members
- At least 1 scholarship offered to a person that self-identifies as a woman.

CEIU has been able to offer scholarships to CEIU members in good standing, their spouse, their common-law spouse (including same sex partners) and/or their dependent(s). The scholarships are presently set in the amount of \$5,000 each. The scholarships do not come from your membership dues, but from the “royalties” CEIU receives from The Personal Insurance and the BMO CEIU Master Card when CEIU members do business with these two (2) companies who offer our members better rates.
