- 1. Much of WMoF will be live-streamed, particularly the panels
- 2. Pope will share the mandate to families at the time of the Angelus on June 27 communicating their mission and message for evangelization.
- 3. Closing Mass in St. Peter's Square
- 4. Will provide a social media page to share, also a web app that they want us to make known.
- 5. Asking people to share pictures the official hashtag is #wmof22
- 6. Hopes that parishes and families will celebrate a "Family Week" can be the week before or the week after as well.
- 7. Suggest holding an opening and closing Eucharistic celebration possibly at a Shrine invited by a letter from the Bishop
- 8. Hold Eucharistic Adoration as families Maybe June 25 (Saturday morning) Could hand out the image and meditation.
- 9. Suggest establishing small groups of families that will carry on the message and mission. Family should feel they are protagonists.
