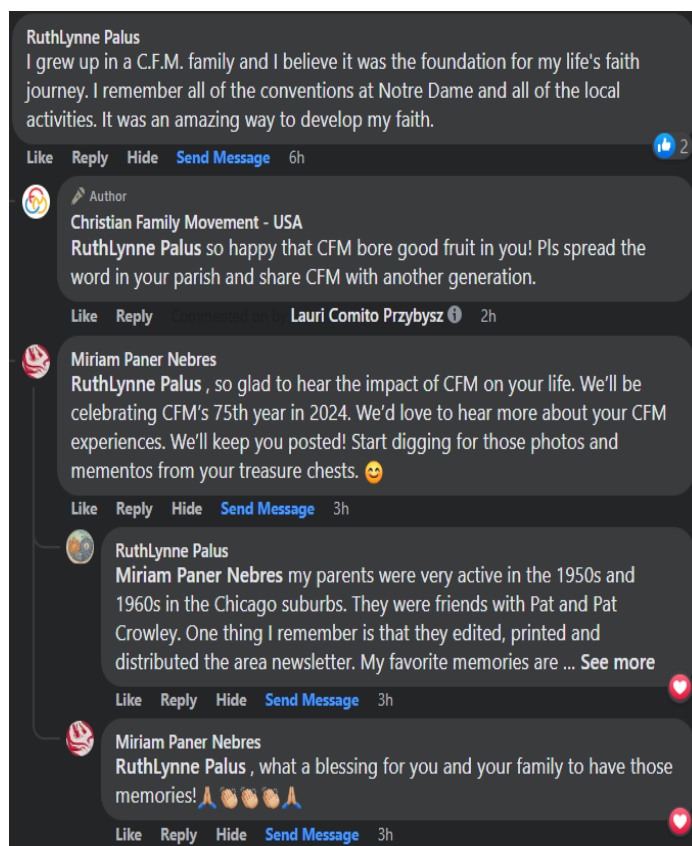
The CFM section of Our Lady of the Fields in Millersville, MD, will be meeting at the church starting in September. They hope to attract more young families.

The James Webb Space Telescope (JWST)



"He counts the number of the stars. He calls them all by their names. Great is our Lord, and mighty in power. His understanding is infinite." Psalm 147:4-5

You may be wondering what the JWST is doing in our ACT newsletter. As some of you may already know, NASA released the first 5 images taken by the JWST on July 12, 2022. One of the engineers who worked on this remarkable groundbreaking telescope is Joe Nebres. Together with his wife, Miriam, they joined the CFM Board in 2021. They belong to the St. Lawrence Martyr—CFM group in Redondo Beach, CA.

As Staff Quality Engineer, Joe worked with various teams for building JWST including (but not limited to) the solar array, membrane release devices for the sunshield, diode modules for the power system, small rockets used for spacecraft orientation, and most especially the top level EIDP for the entire spacecraft (JWST Observatory). Joe was the final approver of the Certificate of Conformance prior to delivery to NASA on December 23, 2021 (two days before launch).

His function was mission assurance for manufacturing, assembly, integration & testing. He has crawled inside the core of the JWST in complete bunny suit & electrostatic discharge straps. It was the most complex spacecraft his company ever built: about 20 years, \$10B, 12,000 technicians, engineers and scientists. At the 2021 Christmas morning launch, Joe gladly saw the solar array deploy perfectly and the small rockets firing intermittently. Fast forward to July 12, NASA released 5 stunning images: their magnificence is a splendid display of the immense power and majesty of God! Thank God and the JWST Team for this human achievement. The humbling spectacle from this mission ultimately glorifies God & points to His creative works and genius. The world is in awe as the heavens declare the glory of God... the world awaits many new scientific revelations of God's amazing creation with this new observatory.
