Our speaker was Fr. Alexis Clement Prakash Fernando,



National Chaplain from CFM Sri Lanka. He presented the Catholic perspective on inter-religious dialogue. The Church recognizes the Holy Spirit's saving activity among all peoples, whatever their religion. Christianity is actually a minority religion (30% worldwide, in Sri Lanka 6%), and we welcome other partners to

heal the world. Christians are called to build bridges of love, to coexist peacefully, to work for the common good in our societies and to uphold the dignity of human life -- while we acknowledge our differences.

At the meeting, we saw more than 50 CFM leaders from Hungary, Philippines, India, Mexico, Spain, Panama, Peru, Malawi, Costa Rica, Thailand, Madagascar, as well as North America Continental Presidents Geremias and Rosario Morales, Past Continental Presidents Wilbur and Juanita Hooker, and Past International and CFM-USA presidents Gary and Kay Aitchison from Iowa.


A woman from St. John the Evangelist Church in Valley, Nebraska is working to start a group for Grandparents meeting during Lent.
