The National Board of Directors is deeply grateful for Fr. Tommy's "yes" to serving as our National Chaplain and looks forward with great hope to the gifts he will bring in service of CFM's mission.

Fr. Tommy was born in Pasadena, California, and raised in a suburb east of Los Angeles. His calling to the priesthood began during his college years. While playing football at a junior college, he suffered a devastating injury that changed the course of his life. During this difficult time, he focused on his faith and deepened his relationship with God. Not long after, he felt called to the priesthood and entered the seminary.

In his third year, however, Fr. Tommy discerned that the priesthood might not be his path and decided to leave. For the next two years, he taught and coached football at a Catholic high school, dated, and earned a master's degree in theology from the Augustine Institute. During this period away, Fr. Tommy again felt a strong call to the priesthood and rejoined the seminary.

Fr. Tommy was ordained on June 1, 2024, for the Archdiocese of Los Angeles and currently serves at St. Philomena Parish in Carson, California. He shares that he loves the priesthood and is deeply grateful to the Lord for calling him to this vocation.


