CFM 75th Anniversary Celebration Frequently Asked Questions

What is the refund policy?

Registration fees are non-refundable. Refunds are discretionary. Please email Rick Hoenig at skhoenig@hotmail.com or call him at 515-231-6895 (Central Time zone) for any concerns or additional information.

Is there a registration deadline?

Yes, the deadline for Early Bird registration is **February 15, 2024, 11:59 pm PT**. The deadline for Regular registration is **July 1, 2024, 11:59 pm PT**.

Can I register in person/at the door?

Due to the upfront costs of putting this celebration together, registration is required in advance. Therefore, registration **will not be** accepted at the door.

I can't stay the whole weekend. Is that, OK?

We will miss celebrating with you – but yes, it is OK.

Can I bring a guest? How much should I pay?

Yes. Guests pay the same registration fees (including early-bird and regular rate). Please note that registration is done as one per family. There is no limit to the number of non-family members/guests who may join the celebration, but they need to register (each as their own family unit) by deadlines outlined above.

Can I bring my own food and picnic on the grounds of Mundelein?

As a sacred space and as a home to theological students and faculty, picnics are not allowed.

Why are children under 18 not allowed to stay at the Mundelein dormitories?

This is a non-negotiable policy of Mundelein.

How old must my child(ren) be to participate in the children's program?

At least 5 years of age.

How do I make payments?

You can pay via personal check, Zelle, or PayPal. For more details, check the registration page and the invoice that you will receive upon registration. When using PayPal, there will be a 4% fee to cover surcharges.

What does the registration fee cover?

The registration fee covers admittance to all activities listed in the Events schedule, not including meals and lodging.

Is there a dress code at this event?

Since we will be on campus at Mundelein Seminary, we ask that you adhere to the campus dress code. Check this link for more information: <u>Visitors - USML</u>. We recommend that you bring comfortable walking shoes as the grounds are beautiful and you are invited to explore and enjoy them.

Where is Mundelein Seminary located and how do I get there?

The University of St. Mary of the Lake is located at 1000 E. Maple Avenue in the town of Mundelein, IL approximately four miles west of Interstate 94. The closest airport is O'Hare International Airport, which is about 28 miles south of USML.

The main entrance off Route 176 is closed. Please enter campus from Route 45 (Lake Street). This entrance is just north of the Route 176/Route 45 intersection. In your GPS, enter "Route 45 and Dunbar/University Mundelein, IL" for directions to this entrance. Once on campus, please follow the signs or the direction of our Public Safety officers to the Purple Parking lot (see map attached).

If you are heading North on Interstate 94:

To reach the seminary from Interstate 94, take the Hwy 176 exit and turn right at the foot of the ramp to head west (the ramp loops around). Continue on 176 to Route 45 and the entrance will be on your right at Dunbar/University street.

If you are heading South on Interstate 94:

To reach the seminary from Interstate 94, take the Exit 10 for IL-21/Milwaukee Ave. Turn right on to Casey Rd and continue to U.S. Route 45. Turn left and continue on Route 45 until you reach the entrance at Dunbar/University street.
