



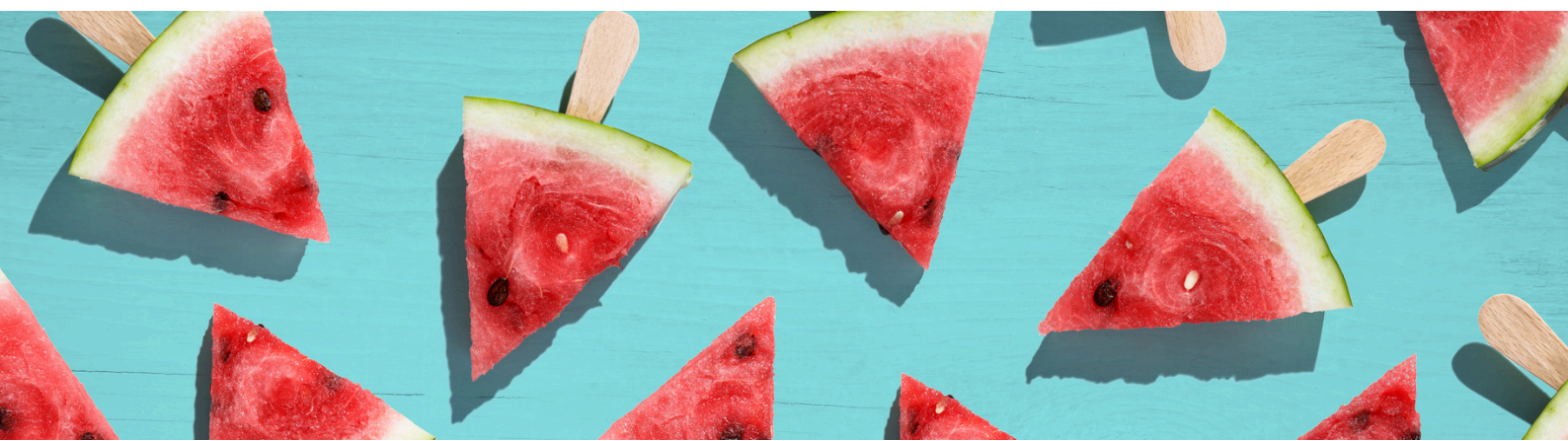

TO DRAW ATTENTION TO CFM IN THE FALL**



Summer is a great time to share CFM with your parish. Look for opportunities to increase CFM's visibility and invite new families to experience the gift of CFM.

DONUTS AFTER MASS

Everyone loves donuts after Mass. Especially kids! Be ready with CFM promotional materials when the little ones drag their parents to your table. Prizes (anything with a CFM logo sticker on it) can serve as great advertisements for CFM. Make sure to have a sign up sheet ready.

CFM SUMMER PICNIC

If your CFM group gets together for a summer picnic, encourage your members to make a special effort in the weeks leading up to it to reach out and invite people from your parish to join you. Maybe you want to focus on families who are new to your parish or the newly married. A personal invitation to meet some CFM families works best.
