- May 6-8 Absentee ballot begins – Judge handles this.
- May 11 Monday, 5pm deadline for Write-In Candidates
- May 14-15 Early Voting – 11am-7pm, Room B**

May 16 Election Day – 7am-7pm, Room B

The committee will recommend the pay be \$15 for the Election Judge and \$12 for the Election Clerk at the March board meeting.
