Important Dates:

- March 18, 2016: Filing deadline for district-level delegates
- March 22, 2016: Primary vote
- April 16, 2016: Congressional district caucuses
- April 22, 2016: Filing deadline for at-large delegates and PLEOs
- May 14, 2016: State convention

Number of Delegates:

- 43 District delegates
- 14 At-large delegates
- 9 Party leaders and elected officials (PLEOs)
- 11 Super-delegates
- Total: 77

Process:

- 1. There is a primary vote taken which determines the proportional allocation of delegates to the district and state conventions.
- 2. Congressional district caucuses are held to elect the district level delegates.
- 3. At the state convention, at-large delegates and PLEOs are elected at the state convention

Allocation of Delegates:

- A candidate must receive 15% of the vote to get delegates at either the district or state level
- At the district level, delegates are split between the 9 congressional districts based on the Democratic make-up of those districts. The delegates are pledged to candidates proportional to the portion of the vote they receive in that district.
- At the state level, 14 at-large delegates and 9 PLEOs are pledged to the candidates based proportionally on the votes of the entire state.

Filing information:

- To qualify as a district-level or at-large delegate, a statement of candidacy designating the presidential preference must be filed with the Arizona Democratic Party at 2910 North Central Avenue, Phoenix, AZ 85012.
- District-level delegates must file in the district or sub district in which they live.
