Important Dates:

- March 8, 2016: Primary vote
- April 25, 2016: Filing deadline for district-level delegation
- May 21, 2016: Congressional district conventions
- May 24, 2016: Filing Deadline for at-large delegation and PLEOs
- June 11, 2016: State Central Committee meeting

Number of Delegates:

- 87 District-Level Delegates
- 29 At-Large Delegates
- 17 Pledged Party Leaders and Elected Officials (PLEOs)
- 19 Super-Delegates
- Total: 152

Process:

- 1. Presidential Primary vote occurs and the number of delegates each candidate receives is allocated proportionally for those that earn over 15% of the vote.
- 2. Congressional district conventions are held to elect district-level delegates
- 3. State Central Committee meeting is held to elect the at-large delegates and PLEOs.

Allocation of Delegates:

- A candidate must receive 15% of the vote to get delegates at either the district or state level.
- At the district level, delegates are split between the 14 congressional districts based on the Democratic make-up of those districts. The delegates are pledged to candidates proportional to the portion of the vote they receive in that district.
- At the state level, 29 at-large delegates and 17 PLEOs are pledged to the candidates based proportionally on the votes of the entire state.

Filing information:

- To qualify as a district-level delegates, at-large delegate, or a PLEO, a statement of candidacy designating the presidential preference must be filed with the State Democratic Party at 606 Townsend, Lansing, MI 48933.
- District-level delegates must file in the district or sub district in which they live
