# Important Dates:

- April 13, 2016: Filing deadline for district-level delegates
- May 1, 2016: District caucuses
- June 7, 2016: Primary vote
- June 10, 2016: Filing deadline for at-large and PLEO delegates
- June 26, 2016: Delegation Meeting

# Number of Delegates:

- 317 District-Level Delegates
- 106 At-Large Delegates
- 53 Pledged Party Leaders and Elected Officials (PLEOs)
- 70 Super-Delegates
- Total: 546

#### Process:

- 1. Pre-primary caucuses are held to slate delegates prior to the primary vote.
- 2. The Primary vote occurs and the number of delegates each candidate receives is allocated based on the results of the vote. The slated delegates are then selected in a pre-designated order.
- 3. The district-level delegates meet at the delegation meeting and elect the at-large and PLEO delegates.

### Allocation of Delegates:

- A candidate must receive 15% of the vote to get delegates at either the district or state level.
- At the district level, delegates are split between the 53 congressional districts based on the Democratic make-up of those districts. The delegates are pledged to candidates proportional to the portion of the vote they receive in that district.
- At the state level, 106 at-large delegates and 53 PLEOs are pledged to the candidates based proportionally on the votes of the entire state.

## Filing information:

- To qualify as a district-level, at-large delegate, or PLEO a statement of candidacy designating the presidential preference must be filed with the State Democratic Party by mail to 1830 9th Street, Sacramento, CA, 9581, by electronic mail to Delegate2016@cadem.org or by fax to 916-442-5715.
- The statement of candidacy and pledge of support forms and filing instructions can be found at the California Democratic Party Headquarters or online at www.cadem.org beginning Monday, February 29, 2016.
- District-level delegates must file in the district or sub district in which they live
