Dear members and staff of the Senate Ethics Committee

CODEPINK: Women for Peace would like to file an ethics complaint to the Senate Ethics Committee regarding the unethical and libelous claims by Senator Tom Cotton and the Senate Republican Conference on the official government Senate GOP X account.

On January 15, 2026, in a tweet to its 1.6 million followers, the official account said:

“Earlier this week, Senate Democrats headlined a CCP-backed Code Pink rally to defund I.C.E. Senate Republicans stand with our brave law enforcement officers who keep America safe.”

The post has two major lies. First, CODEPINK is not “CCP-backed.” As we have officially stated multiple times, CODEPINK receives no money from China or any foreign governments or political parties. CODEPINK is funded by donations from individuals as well as through administrative grants for non-profits. CODEPINK has no contact with the Chinese Communist Party.

Secondly, the protest that they are referring to was not organized by CODEPINK. It appears this rally was organized by Indivisible - something the organization was well within its First Amendment rights to do.

We call on the Senate GOP to stop lying about CODEPINK and represent the actual needs of the people, many of whom have recently lost their access to healthcare, thanks in part to the Senate GOP. We demand that the Senate GOP account delete or correct the libelous post.
