We are off to a great start this year in terms of our progress. In January, we launched our [postcard program](#) and have been steadily sending postcards for the April elections and voter outreach efforts. We have sent over 166K postcards this year alone—every day, someone who hasn't taken action yet jumps in. Our community hubs are thriving.

In February, we launched our [CTD Phone Bank Program](#) and have two teams - our Monday team and Wednesday team, along with successful [small group training](#) on Tuesdays. We have already made it through 30% of the Wisconsin Supreme Court Race calls. **Come on out and help us finish the list by end of February!** We welcome any group that would like to join us for our phone banks. Currently, we have members from **TurnUp** joining us, which is new and exciting!

1. SF East Bay Contra Costa this Saturday, hosted by Concord Immigrant Protections Network (CIPN) in partnership with IRCC and CTD.*Saturday, February 14, 2026 10:30 am - 12 noon ***
NOTE EARLIER START and END TIMES. CONCORD THEME: LOVE YOUR NEIGHBOR. Dress in pink, red, or white. In lieu of our usual protest, we'll be joining and supporting this special event led by Concord Immigrant Protections Network (CIPN) and other local grassroots groups.
 - The event will open with a rally at the former Big Lots parking lot at 2160 Monument Blvd, Concord, followed by a march through the neighborhood to Meadow Homes Park on Sunshine Ave. & Detroit Ave., CONCORD. The march will conclude with music, guest speakers, and a call to action at Meadow Homes Park.
 - We recommend that you choose one of three options:

(1) Park at 2160 Monument Blvd, CONCORD (former Big Lots parking lot) and join the march to Meadow Homes Park,

(2) Park at 2160 Monument (former Big Lots parking lot) and stay near the intersection of Oak Grove Road and Monument for a Honk & Wave, or

(3) Drive directly to Meadow Homes Park and do a Honk & Wave with your sign until the march arrives and the rally begins.

- NOTE: If you choose Option 1, you will need to march back to your car after the rally at Meadow Homes Park. (It's a 2-mile loop.) We suggest that anyone with mobility challenges choose Option 2 or
