


SOMA Celebrates Women's History Month!

Community Coalition on Race 2022 Demographics Report: Presentation & Video

The MERT Committee of the Community Coalition on Race presented its 2022 Demographics Report to the community. Updating previous reports from 2016 and 2019 that relied on 2010 the US Census and subsequent American Community Survey polls, the report focusses on racial integration and diversity trends in South Orange and Maplewood over 20 years with 2020 US Census information.
