## **Victorian Government**

### **Sporting Club Grants Program**

**Closes 26 November 2025 - *closes soon***

The Sporting Club Grants Program provides funding for community sport and active recreation organisations across Victoria.

### **Animal Welfare Fund Grants**

**Closes 27 November 2025 - *closes soon***

This grant supports animal shelter organisations promoting responsible animal ownership education, community foster care networks, not-for-profit and low-cost veterinary services and groups that provide relief facilities and services during an emergency.

### **Energy Innovation Fund**

**Closes 28 November 2025 - *closes soon***

Supporting the commercialisation of emerging, innovative and transformational renewable energy technologies and projects.

### **Stronger Fishing Clubs Grant Program**

**Closes 30 November 2025**

This grant program aims to strengthen fishing clubs and help them attract new members, improve their facilities, and promote participation amongst all ages and abilities.

### **Circular Economy Infrastructure Fund**

#### **Closes 1 December 2025**

This grant supports registered charities to install new, or upgrade existing, battery drop off points and to promote those locations. Funded activities focus on infrastructure purchase and installation at convenient locations and advertising costs.

### **Local Sports Infrastructure Fund**

#### **Closes 2 December 2025**

The Fund aims to deliver new and upgraded community sports infrastructure across 3 streams including community Facilities, community Sports Lighting and planning. Open to Victorian Local Government Authorities

### **Aboriginal Community Infrastructure Program**

#### **Closes 3 December 2025**

Funding up to \$1.6 million is available for First Nations organisations to improve functionality, repair, refurbish or expand infrastructure, or plan future infrastructure.

### **Touring Victoria**

#### **Closes 4 December 2025**

This grant supports Victorian arts and cultural organisations or professional creative practitioners to tour a professional production, performance, exhibition or program to, or from, regional and outer-metropolitan Victoria.

### **Significant Sporting Events Program**

#### **Closes 15 December 2025**

Funding program that assists event organisers to enhance the delivery of national or international level sporting events in Victoria.

### **2025-26 Multicultural Infrastructure and Security Program**

#### **Closes 5 January 2026**

Grants of up to \$400,000 are available to maintain, upgrade, and secure multicultural community infrastructure.

### **Disability Self Help Grants Program**

#### **Closes 27 January 2026**

The Disability self help grants program provides grants to Victorian disability self help groups. Grants of up to \$7,000 per year for 1 or 2 years are available.

### **Restoring Community War Memorials and Avenues of Honour Grant Program**

#### **Closes 3 February 2026**

Grants to conserve, maintain, or restore community war memorials, honour rolls and avenues of honour for local veterans.

### **Veterans Capital Works Grant Program**

**Closes 3 February 2026**

Grants to help not-for-profit organisations build or improve facilities that deliver services to veterans, their families, and communities. This includes accessibility, amenity, and small infrastructure projects.

### **Emergency Sporting Equipment Grant Program**

**Closes 31 May 2026**

Helps grassroots organisations replace or repair essential sport or first aid equipment that has been lost or destroyed because of unpreventable incidents, including bushfire, flood, significant storm, earthquake, theft, arson, or criminal damage.

### **Small Business Bus**

**Ongoing**

The Small Business Bus visits metropolitan Melbourne and regional Victoria as an 'office on wheels'. It offers friendly and professional assistance with experts.

## **Community & Support**

### **Multicultural Grassroots Initiatives – Round 2 (Australian Government)**

**Closes 5 December 2025**

This grant supports events and programs that increase awareness and grow participation and collaboration across different cultural, ethnic and social groups in our community.

### **Community Grants (Prostate Cancer Foundation of Australia - PCFA)**

**Closes 19 December 2025**

PCFA-affiliated support groups can apply for small grants to deliver community events and awareness building activities to inform and educate the community.

### **Stronger Communities Programme (Australian Government)**

**Closes 15 January 2026**

Through this program, Federal Members of Parliament (MPs) identify potential small infrastructure projects that provide social benefit for local communities and invite applications from organisations in their electorate.

## **Health**

### **Community Awareness Grants (Australian Government)**

**Closes 15 December 2025**

Grants are available to build support for organ and tissue donation through running a local event or activity to support DonateLife Week 2026.

## **Creative & Arts**

### **Digital Specialist in Residence for First Nations Organisations program (Creative Australia)**

**Closes 2 December 2025**

This grant provides First Nations arts and culture organisations with access to a specialist to assist in the development of the organisation's digital capacity and related projects.

### **Music Australia Export Development Fund (Creative Australia)**

**Closes 2 December 2025**

Three grants are now available to support international performance and touring, market and audience development activities as well as professional development for Australian musicians.

### **Documentary Producer - Funding and Support (Screen Australia)**

**Closes 29 January 2026**

The program supports the productions and completion of one-off and series documentaries

## **Veterans**

### **Saluting Their Service Commemorative Grants Program - Community Grants (Veterans' Affairs)**

**Closes 5 February 2026**

This small grant is for projects that are community-based and commemorate the service and roles of those who have served, and to preserve and provide access to information about Australia's wartime heritage.

## **Older People**

### **Building Digital Skills Grants (Good Things Foundation)**

**Closes 28 November 2025 - *closes soon***

These grants help community organisations to deliver digital mentoring and learning sessions for older people to develop their digital skills and confidence.

## **First Nations**

### **First Nations Documentary Development (Australian Government)**

**Closes 15 January 2026**

This Screen Australia grant supports practitioners to create appropriate written and/or visual materials when competing for production finance. Emerging Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander producers are encouraged to apply.
