Report: Minneapolis police officer arrested for allegedly driving drunk

A Minneapolis police officer was arrested Tuesday on suspicion of drunken driving, local television stations are reporting.

Officer Jeffrey Pennaz, 31, was arrested in Plymouth and booked into Hennepin County Jail on probable cause driving while intoxicated, according to KSTP-TV. He was later released and has not been formally charged, the station said.

Pennaz was driving with children in his car, according to WCCO-TV. It is unclear how many children were in the car or if they were Pennaz's children, the station said.

Pennaz is an officer in the Third Precinct, WCCO said.
